AN ACT

To provide for the reinstatement of a license for a certain
Federal Energy Regulatory Commission project.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. REINSTATEMENT OF LICENSE FOR FEDERAL**
2 **ENERGY REGULATORY COMMISSION**
3 **PROJECT.**

4 (a) IN GENERAL.—Notwithstanding the time period
5 specified in section 13 of the Federal Power Act (16
6 U.S.C. 806) that would otherwise apply to project num-
7 bered 7307 of the Federal Energy Regulatory Commis-
8 sion, the Commission shall, on the request of the licensee
9 for the project, in accordance with that section (including
10 the good faith, due diligence, and public interest require-
11 ments of that section and procedures established under
12 that section), extend the time required for commencement
13 of construction of the project until December 31, 2007.

14 (b) APPLICABILITY.—Subsection (a) shall apply to
15 the project on the expiration of any extension, issued by
16 the Commission under section 13 of the Federal Power
17 Act (16 U.S.C. 806), of the time required for commence-
18 ment of construction of the project.

19 (c) REINSTATEMENT OF TERMINATED LICENSE.—If
20 a license of the Commission for the project has been termi-
21 nated before the date of enactment of this Act, the Com-
22 mission shall—

23 (1) reinstate the license effective as of the date
24 of the termination of the license; and

1 (2) extend the time required for commencement
2 of construction of the project until December 31,
3 2007.
