A BILL

For the relief of Gustav F.K. Wallner.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. PERMANENT RESIDENCE.
- 4 Notwithstanding any other provision of law, for pur-
- 5 poses of the Immigration and Nationality Act (8 U.S.C.
- 6 1101 et seq.), Gustav F.K. Wallner shall be held and con-
- 7 sidered to have been lawfully admitted to the United
- 8 States for permanent residence as of the date of the enact-
- 9 ment of this Act upon payment of the required visa fee.
- 10 SEC. 2. REDUCTION OF NUMBER OF AVAILABLE VISAS.
- 11 Upon the granting of permanent residence to Gustav
- 12 F.K. Wallner as provided in this Act, the Secretary of

- 1 State shall instruct the proper officer to reduce by 1 dur-
- 2 ing the current fiscal year the total number of immigrant
- 3 visas available to natives of the country of the alien's birth
- 4 under section 203(a) of the Immigration and Nationality

5 Act (8 U.S.C. 1153(a)).
