A BILL

To ensure payment of United States assessments for United
Nations peacekeeping operations in 2005 and 2006.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. LIMITATION ON THE UNITED STATES SHARE OF**
4 **ASSESSMENTS FOR UNITED NATIONS PEACE-**
5 **KEEPING OPERATIONS.**

6 (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 404(b)(2)(B) of the For-
7 eign Relations Authorization Act, Fiscal Years 1994 and
8 1995 (22 U.S.C. 287e note) is amended by adding at the
9 end the following new clause:

1 “(v) For assessments made during
2 calendar year 2005 and 2006, 27.1 per-
3 cent.”.

4 (b) CONFORMING AMENDMENT.—Section 411 of the
5 Department of State and Related Agency Appropriations
6 Act, 2005 (title IV of division B of Public Law 108–447;
7 22 U.S.C. 287e note) is repealed.
