- 6 amended by inserting before the semicolon the following:
- 7 "and contemporaneous, real-time, or prospective informa-
- 8 tion regarding the physical location of a cellular tele-
- 9 phone".

- 2 Section 3117(b) of title 18, United States Code, is
- 3 amended by inserting before the period the following: ",
- 4 including a cellular telephone for which the government
- 5 seeks contemporaneous, real-time, or prospective informa-
- 6 tion regarding the physical location of such phone".
