## A BILL

To amend title 9, United States Code, to provide for greater fairness in the arbitration process relating to livestock and poultry contracts.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Fair Contracts for
- 5 Growers Act of 2005".
- 6 SEC. 2. ELECTION OF ARBITRATION.
- 7 (a) IN GENERAL.—Chapter 1 of title 9, United
- 8 States Code, is amended by adding at the end the fol-
- 9 lowing:

### "§ 17. Livestock and poultry contracts

- 2 "(a) Definitions.—In this section:
- 3 "(1) LIVESTOCK.—The term 'livestock' has the 4 meaning given the term in section 2(a) of the Pack-
- 5 ers and Stockyards Act, 1921 (7 U.S.C. 182(a)).
- 6 "(2) LIVESTOCK OR POULTRY CONTRACT.—The
  7 term 'livestock or poultry contract' means any
  8 growout contract, marketing agreement, or other ar-
- 9 rangement under which a livestock or poultry grower
- 10 raises and cares for livestock or poultry.
- 11 "(3) Livestock or Poultry Grower.—The
- term 'livestock or poultry grower' means any person
- engaged in the business of raising and caring for
- livestock or poultry in accordance with a livestock or
- poultry contract, whether the livestock or poultry is
- owned by the person or by another person.
- 17 "(4) POULTRY.—The term 'poultry' has the
- meaning given the term in section 2(a) of the Pack-
- 19 ers and Stockyards Act, 1921 (7 U.S.C. 182(a)).
- 20 "(b) Consent to Arbitration.—If a livestock or
- 21 poultry contract provides for the use of arbitration to re-
- 22 solve a controversy under the livestock or poultry contract,
- 23 arbitration may be used to settle the controversy only if,
- 24 after the controversy arises, both parties consent in writ-
- 25 ing to use arbitration to settle the controversy.

- 1 "(c) Explanation of Basis for Awards.—If arbi-
- 2 tration is elected to settle a dispute under a livestock or
- 3 poultry contract, the arbitrator shall provide to the parties
- 4 to the contract a written explanation of the factual and
- 5 legal basis for the award.".
- 6 (b) Technical and Conforming Amendment.—
- 7 The table of sections for chapter 1 of title 9, United States
- 8 Code, is amended by adding at the end the following:
  "17. Livestock and poultry contracts.".

#### 9 SEC. 3. EFFECTIVE DATE.

- The amendments made by section 2 shall apply to
- 11 a contract entered into, amended, altered, modified, re-
- 12 newed, or extended after the date of enactment of this Act.
