## A BILL

To authorize full funding of payments for eligible federally connected children under title VIII of the Elementary and Secondary Education Act of 1965 by fiscal year 2011.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3       **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4       This Act may be cited as the “Fair Share for Military  
5       Children in Public Schools Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. PAYMENTS FOR ELIGIBLE FEDERALLY CONNECTED**  
2 **CHILDREN UNDER TITLE VIII OF THE ELE-**  
3 **MENTARY AND SECONDARY EDUCATION ACT**  
4 **OF 1965.**

5 Section 8014(b) of the Elementary and Secondary  
6 Education Act of 1965 (20 U.S.C. 7714(b)) is amended  
7 to read as follows:

8 “(b) BASIC PAYMENTS; PAYMENTS FOR HEAVILY IM-  
9 PACTED LOCAL EDUCATIONAL AGENCIES.—For the pur-  
10 pose of making payments under section 8003(b), there are  
11 authorized to be appropriated—

12 “(1) for fiscal year 2007, such sums as may be  
13 necessary to pay to each local educational agency for  
14 such fiscal year 70.4 percent of the full amount com-  
15 puted for such agency for such fiscal year under  
16 paragraphs (1) and (2) of section 8003(b);

17 “(2) for fiscal year 2008, such sums as may be  
18 necessary to pay to each local educational agency for  
19 such fiscal year 77.8 percent of the full amount com-  
20 puted for such agency for such fiscal year under  
21 paragraphs (1) and (2) of section 8003(b);

22 “(3) for fiscal year 2009, such sums as may be  
23 necessary to pay to each local educational agency for  
24 such fiscal year 85.2 percent of the full amount com-  
25 puted for such agency for such fiscal year under  
26 paragraphs (1) and (2) of section 8003(b);

1           “(4) for fiscal year 2010, such sums as may be  
2           necessary to pay to each local educational agency for  
3           such fiscal year 92.6 percent of the full amount com-  
4           puted for such agency for such fiscal year under  
5           paragraphs (1) and (2) of section 8003(b); and

6           “(5) for fiscal year 2011, such sums as may be  
7           necessary to pay to each local educational agency for  
8           such fiscal year the full amount computed for such  
9           agency for such fiscal year under paragraphs (1)  
10          and (2) of section 8003(b).”.
