4	(a) In General.—Section 2255(a) of title 18,
5	United States Code, is amended—
6	(1) in the first sentence—
7	(A) by striking "(a) Any minor who is"
8	and inserting the following:
9	"(a) In General.—Any person who, while a minor,

2	following: ", regardless of whether the injury
3	occurred while such person was a minor,"; and
4	(C) by striking "such minor" and inserting
5	"such person"; and
6	(2) in the second sentence—
7	(A) by striking "Any minor" and inserting
8	"Any person"; and
9	(B) by striking "\$50,000" and inserting
10	"\$150,000".
11	(b) Conforming Amendment.—Section 2255(b) of
12	title 18, United States Code, is amended by striking "(b)
13	Any action" and inserting the following:
14	"(b) Statute of Limitations.—Any action".
