## A BILL

To amend titles 10 and 38 of the United States Code, to increase and index educational benefits for veterans under the Montgomery GI bill to ensure adequate and equitable benefits for active duty members and members of the selected Reserve, and to include certain servicemembers previously excluded from such benefits.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-

- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- This Act may be cited as the "Armed Forces Edu-
- 5 cation Benefits Improvement Act".

1	SEC. 2. ADJUSTMENT AND ANNUAL DETERMINATION OF
2	EDUCATIONAL ASSISTANCE UNDER THE
3	MONTGOMERY GI BILL FOR ACTIVE DUTY
4	MEMBERS.
5	(a) In General.—Section 3015 of title 38, United
6	States Code, is amended—
7	(1) in subsection (a), by amending paragraph
8	(1) to read as follows:

11	"(A) \$1,584 per month for months during
12	fiscal year 2005; and
13	"(B) for months during fiscal year 2006
14	and each subsequent fiscal year, the monthly

16	fiscal year multiplied by the percentage increase
17	calculated under subsection (h); or";
18	(2) in subsection (b), by amending paragraph
19	(1) to read as follows:

23	fiscal year 2005; and
24	"(B) for months during fiscal year 2006
25	and each subsequent fiscal year, the monthly

3	(3) in subsection (h)(1), by striking "all items"
4	and inserting "college tuition and fees".
5	(b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendments made by
6	subsection (a) shall take effect on the first day of the first
7	month beginning after the date of enactment of this Act.
8	SEC. 3. ANALYSIS OF IMPACT OF MONTGOMERY GI BILL
9	EDUCATIONAL BENEFITS.
10	(a) FINDINGS.—Congress finds that—
11	(1) the enhanced educational benefits provided
12	under the Ronald W. Reagan National Defense Au-
13	thorization Act for Fiscal Year 2005 are an impor-
14	tant step in ensuring that members of the Selected
15	Reserve are thanked for their increasing role in the
16	modern warfare; and
17	(2) when these members return from extended
18	tours in Iraq, Afghanistan, and other places, they
19	should be provided with immediate access to these
20	enhanced educational benefits.
21	(b) Cooperation.—The Secretary of Defense shall
22	work expeditiously with the Secretary of Veterans Affairs
23	to ensure that members of the Selected Reserve receive
24	the educational benefits referred to in subsection (a) in
25	a timely manner.

## (c) Studies.—

- (1) Secretary of Defense.—The Secretary of Defense shall conduct a study analyzing the effect of all Montgomery GI bill educational benefits on recruitment and retention during the 12-month period beginning on the date on which the enhanced benefits referred to in subsection (a) become available.
  - (2) Secretary of Veterans Affairs shall conduct a study analyzing the effect of all Montgomery GI bill educational benefits on the readjustment of veterans eligible for educational benefits under section 3015 of title 38, United States Code, and chapters 1606 and 1607 of title 10, United States Code, during the 12-month period beginning on the date on which the enhanced benefits referred to in subsection (a) become available.
  - (3) Report.—Not later than 18 months after the date on which the enhanced benefits referred to in subsection (a) become available, the Secretary of Defense and the Secretary of Veterans Affairs shall submit a report on the results of the studies conducted under paragraphs (1) and (2) to—
