- 5 (a) In General.—The Director of National Intel-
- 6 ligence shall submit to the congressional intelligence com-
- 7 mittees any Presidential Daily Briefing (PDB), or any
- 8 portion of a Presidential Daily Briefing, of the Director

- 1 of Central Intelligence during the period beginning on
- 2 January 20, 1997, and ending on March 19, 2003, that
- 3 refers to Iraq or otherwise addresses Iraq in any fashion.
- 4 (b) Congressional Intelligence Committees
- 5 Defined.—In this section, the term "congressional intel-
- 6 ligence committees" means—
- 7 (1) the Select Committee on Intelligence of the
- 8 Senate; and
- 9 (2) the Permanent Select Committee on Intel-
- ligence of the House of Representatives.
