- 3 SECTION 1. CERTAIN MANUFACTURING EQUIPMENT USED
- 4 FOR WORKING IRON OR STEEL.
- 5 (a) In General.—Heading 9902.84.83 of the Har-
- 6 monized Tariff Schedule of the United States (relating to
- 7 certain manufacturing equipment) is amended by striking
- 8 "12/31/2006" and inserting "12/31/2009".
- 9 (b) Effective Date.—The amendment made by
- 10 subsection (a) applies to goods entered, or withdrawn from

- 1 warehouse for consumption, on or after the 15th day after
- 2 the date of enactment of this Act.
