Mrs. FEINSTEIN introduced the following bill; which was read twice and referred to the Committee on the Judiciary

## A BILL

For the relief of Carmen Shahrzad Kulcsar.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. PERMANENT RESIDENCE.**

4 Notwithstanding any other provision of law or any  
5 order, for purposes of the Immigration and Nationality  
6 Act (8 U.S.C. 1101 et seq.), Carmen Shahrzad Kulcsar  
7 shall be deemed to have been lawfully admitted to the  
8 United States for permanent residence as of the date of  
9 enactment of this Act upon the payment of the required  
10 visa fees.

1 **SEC. 2. REDUCTION OF NUMBER OF AVAILABLE VISAS.**

2       Upon the granting of permanent residence to Carmen  
3 Shahrzad Kulesar under section 1, the Secretary of State  
4 shall instruct the proper officer to reduce by 1 the total  
5 number of immigrant visas available during the current  
6 fiscal year to natives of the country of the alien's birth  
7 under section 203(a) of the Immigration and Nationality  
8 Act (8 U.S.C. 1153(a)).
