- 3 SECTION 1. MEMBERSHIP OF BOARD OF DIRECTORS.
- 4 Section 2(a)(1) of the Tennessee Valley Authority Act
- 5 of 1933 (16 U.S.C. 831(a)(1)) is amended—
- 6 (1) by striking "9" and inserting "13"; and

1 (2) by striking "at least" and all that follows 2 and inserting ", of whom at least 1 member shall be 3 a legal resident of each State in the service area of 4 the Corporation.".
