A BILL

For the relief of Ernesto Guillen.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. PERMANENT RESIDENCE.**

4 Notwithstanding any other provision of law, for pur-
5 poses of the Immigration and Nationality Act (8 U.S.C.
6 1101 et seq.), Ernesto Guillen shall be held and considered
7 to have been lawfully admitted to the United States for
8 permanent residence as of the date of enactment of this
9 Act upon payment of any necessary visa fees.

10 **SEC. 2. REDUCTION OF NUMBER OF AVAILABLE VISAS.**

11 Upon the granting of permanent residence to Ernesto
12 Guillen under section 1, the Secretary of State shall in-

1 struct the proper officer to reduce by one the total number
2 of immigrant visas available during the current fiscal year
3 to natives of the country of the alien's birth under section
4 202(e) of the Immigration and Nationality Act (8 U.S.C.
5 1152(e)).
