## A BILL

For the relief of Ernesto Guillen.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. PERMANENT RESIDENCE.
- 4 Notwithstanding any other provision of law, for pur-
- 5 poses of the Immigration and Nationality Act (8 U.S.C.
- 6 1101 et seq.), Ernesto Guillen shall be held and considered
- 7 to have been lawfully admitted to the United States for
- 8 permanent residence as of the date of enactment of this
- 9 Act upon payment of any necessary visa fees.
- 10 SEC. 2. REDUCTION OF NUMBER OF AVAILABLE VISAS.
- 11 Upon the granting of permanent residence to Ernesto
- 12 Guillen under section 1, the Secretary of State shall in-

- 1 struct the proper officer to reduce by one the total number
- 2 of immigrant visas available during the current fiscal year
- 3 to natives of the country of the alien's birth under section
- 4 202(e) of the Immigration and Nationality Act (8 U.S.C.

5 1152(e)).
