7 Section 1886(h)(2)(D)(iii) of the Social Security Act 8 (42 U.S.C. 1395ww(h)(2)(D)(iii)) is amended by striking "and for the cost reporting period beginning during fiscal 9 year 2002 shall not be less than 85 percent" and inserting 10 ", for cost reporting periods beginning during or after fis-11 cal year 2002 (and before fiscal year 2006) shall not be 12 less than 85 percent, and for cost reporting periods begin-13 14 ning during or after fiscal year 2006 shall not be less than 100 percent". 15

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
