A BILL

To amend the National Organ Transplant Act to clarify that kidney paired donation and kidney list donation do not involve the transfer of a human organ for valuable consideration.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Living Kidney Organ
5 Donation Clarification Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. AMENDMENT TO THE NATIONAL ORGAN TRANS-**
2 **PLANT ACT.**

3 Section 301(a) of the National Organ Transplant Act
4 (42 U.S.C. 274e(a)) is amended by adding at the end the
5 following: “For purposes of this section, kidney paired do-
6 nation and kidney list donation shall not be considered to
7 involve the transfer of a human organ for valuable consid-
8 eration.”.
