A BILL

To amend the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 to modify the definition of agri-biodiesel.

1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the United States of America in Congress assembled, 3 SECTION 1. MODIFICATION OF DEFINITION OF AGRI-BIO-4 DIESEL. 5 (a) In General.—Paragraph (2) of section 40A(d) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 (relating to agri-7 biodiesel) is amended to read as follows: 8 AGRI-BIODIESEL.—The term 'agri-bio-9 diesel' means biodiesel derived solely from esters de-10 rived from—

1	"(A) virgin vegetable oils—
2	"(i) from corn, soybeans, sunflower
3	seeds, cottonseeds, canola, crambe,
4	rapeseeds, safflowers, flaxseeds, rice bran,
5	and mustard seeds, and
6	"(ii) which have a cloud point of 45
7	degrees or less, and
8	"(B) animal fats.".
9	(b) Effective Date.—The amendment made by
10	this section shall apply to fuel sold or used after the date
11	of the enactment of this Act.
