A BILL

To ensure the proper remembrance of Vietnam veterans and the Vietnam War by providing a deadline for the designation of a visitor center for the Vietnam Veterans Memorial.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Vietnam Veterans Me-
- 5 morial Visitor Center Deadline Enforcement Act".

SEC. 2. DEADLINE FOR APPROVAL OF VIETNAM VETERANS 2 MEMORIAL VISITOR CENTER. 3 Section 6 of Public Law 96–297 (16 U.S.C. 431 note; 4 94 Stat. 827, 117 Stat. 1348) is amended— 5 (1) in subsection (a), by striking paragraph (2) 6 and inserting the following: 7 "(2) LOCATION.—The visitor center shall be lo-8 cated underground in the triangular land area between Henry Bacon Drive, 23rd Street, Constitution 9 10 Avenue, and the Lincoln Memorial in the District of Columbia."; and 11 12 (2) by adding at the end the following: "(e) DEADLINE FOR APPROVAL.—Notwithstanding 13 any other provision of law, final approval of the visitor center shall occur not later than 30 days after the date 16 of enactment of this subsection.".
