A BILL

To increase penalties for trafficking with respect to peonage, slavery, involuntary servitude, or forced labor.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. AMENDMENT TO TITLE 18.
- 4 The text of section 1590 of title 18, United States
- 5 Code, is amended to read as follows: "Whoever knowingly
- 6 recruits, harbors, transports, provides, or obtains by any
- 7 means, any person for labor or services in violation of this
- 8 chapter shall be fined under this title and imprisoned for
- 9 any term of years or life. If death results from the viola-
- 10 tion of this section, or if the violation includes kidnaping

- 1 or an attempt to kidnap, aggravated sexual abuse or the
- 2 attempt to commit aggravated sexual abuse, or an attempt
- 3 to kill, the defendant shall be fined under this title and
- 4 imprisoned for any term of years or life. If such violation
- 5 involves kidnaping more than 1 person, or involves aggra-
- 6 vated sexual assault on more than 1 person, the defendant
- 7 shall be subject to the death penalty.".
