Mr. MENENDEZ introduced the following bill; which was read twice and referred to the Committee on the Judiciary

A BILL

To permit access to certain information in the Firearms Trace System database.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. FIREARMS TRACE SYSTEM.**

4 (a) IN GENERAL.—The Science, State, Justice, Com-
5 merce, and Related Agencies Appropriations Act, 2006
6 (Public Law 109–108; 119 Stat. 2295) is amended in title
7 I, under the heading “BUREAU OF ALCOHOL, TOBACCO,
8 FIREARMS AND EXPLOSIVES”, by striking “*Provided fur-*
9 *ther,* That no funds appropriated under this or any other
10 Act with respect to any fiscal year may be used to disclose

1 part or all of the contents of the Firearms Trace System
2 database” and all that follows through “section
3 921(a)(10) of such title:”.

4 (b) ACCESS TO INFORMATION.—The Attorney Gen-
5 eral shall provide public access to the Crime Gun Trace
6 Report (both nationally and for individual cities) from the
7 Youth Crime Gun Interdiction Initiative, which is gen-
8 erated using information in the Firearms Trace System
9 database maintained by the Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco,
10 Firearms and Explosives.
