A BILL

To suspend temporarily the duty on aerosol valves designed to deliver a metered dose (50 microliters) of a pressurized liquid pharmaceutical.

2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. CERTAIN AEROSOL VALVES.**

4 (a) IN GENERAL.—Subchapter II of chapter 99 of
5 the Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the United States is
6 amended by inserting in numerical sequence the following
7 new heading:

“	9902.84.82	Aerosol valves designed to deliver a metered dose (50 microliters) of a pressurized liquid pharmaceutical with a mounting cup inside diameter of 20.1 mm, a mounting cup height (skirt to shoulder) of 7.49 mm, stem outside diameter of 2.79 mm, with components made of stainless steel and buna rubber with a retaining cup of aluminum (provided for in subheading 8481.80.30)	Free	No Change	No Change	12/31/2009	”.

1 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by
 2 this section applies to goods entered, or withdrawn from
 3 warehouse for consumption, on or after the date that is
