A BILL

To amend the Omnibus Crime Control and Safe Streets Act of 1968 to clarify that Indian tribes are eligible to receive grants for confronting the use of methamphetamine.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Native American Meth-
5 amphetamine Enforcement and Treatment Act of 2006”.

1 **SEC. 2. NATIVE AMERICAN PARTICIPATION IN METH-**
 2 **AMPHETAMINE GRANTS.**

3 (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 2996(a) of the Omnibus
 4 Crime Control and Safe Streets Act of 1968 is amended—

5 (1) in paragraph (1)—

6 (A) in the matter preceding subparagraph
 7 (A), by inserting “, territories, and Indian
 8 tribes (as defined in section 2704)” after “to
 9 assist States”; and

10 (B) in subparagraph (B), by striking “and
 11 local” and inserting “territorial, Tribal, and
 12 local”;

13 (2) in paragraph (2), by inserting “, territories,
 14 and Indian tribes” after “make grants to States”;
 15 and

16 (3) in paragraph (3)(C), by inserting “, Trib-
 17 al,” after “support State”.

18 (b) GRANT PROGRAMS FOR DRUG ENDANGERED
 19 CHILDREN.—Section 755(a) of the USA PATRIOT Im-
 20 provement and Reauthorization Act of 2005 is amended
 21 by inserting “, territories, and Indian tribes (as defined
 22 in section 2704 of the Omnibus Crime Control and Safe
 23 Streets Act of 1968 (42 U.S.C. 3797d))” after “make
 24 grants to States”.

25 (c) GRANT PROGRAMS TO ADDRESS METHAMPHET-
 26 AMINE USE BY PREGNANT AND PARENTING WOMEN OF-

1 FENDERS.—Section 756 of the USA PATRIOT Improve-
 2 ment and Reauthorization Act of 2005 is amended—

3 (1) in subsection (a)(2), by inserting “, terri-
 4 torial, or Tribal” after “State”;

5 (2) in subsection (b)—

6 (A) in paragraph (1)—

7 (i) by inserting “, territorial, or Trib-
 8 al” after “State”; and

9 (ii) by striking “and/or” and inserting
 10 “or”;

11 (B) in paragraph (2)—

12 (i) by inserting “, territory, or Indian
 13 tribe” after “agency of the State”; and

14 (ii) by inserting “, territory, or Indian
 15 tribe” after “criminal laws of that State”;

16 and

17 (C) by adding at the end the following:

18 “(3) INDIAN TRIBE.—The term ‘Indian tribe’
 19 has the same meaning as in section 2704 of the Om-
 20 nibus Crime Control and Safe Streets Act of 1968
 21 (42 U.S.C. 3797d)).”; and

22 (3) in subsection (c)—

23 (A) in paragraph (3), by striking “Indian
 24 Tribe” and inserting “Indian tribe”; and

25 (B) in paragraph (4)—

1 (i) in the matter preceding subpara-
2 graph (A)—

3 (I) by striking “State’s services”
4 and inserting “services of the State,
5 territory, or Tribe”; and

6 (II) by striking “and/or” and in-
7 serting “or”;

8 (ii) in subparagraph (A), by striking
9 “State”;

10 (iii) in subparagraph (C), by inserting
11 “, Indian tribes,” after “involved coun-
12 ties”; and

13 (iv) in subparagraph (D), by inserting
14 “, Tribal” after “Federal, State”.
