To amend the Federal Cigarette Labeling and Advertising Act with respect to the labeling of cigarette packages, and for other purposes.

Mr. LIEBERMAN introduced the following bill; which was read twice and referred to the Committee on Commerce, Science, and Transportation

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## A BILL

To amend the Federal Cigarette Labeling and Advertising Act with respect to the labeling of cigarette packages, and for other purposes.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3       **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4       This Act may be cited as the “Cigarette Litter Pre-  
5       vention Act”.

6       **SEC. 2. REQUIRED STATEMENT ON CIGARETTE PACKAGES.**

7       Section 4(a) of the Federal Cigarette Labeling and  
8       Advertising Act (15 U.S.C. 1333(a)) is amended by add-  
9       ing at the end the following:

1           “(4)(A) It shall be unlawful for any person to  
2           manufacture, package, or import for sale or distribu-  
3           tion within the United States any cigarettes the  
4           package of which fails to bear, in accordance with  
5           the regulations promulgated by the Secretary under  
6           subparagraph (B), the following statement: ‘Please  
7           dispose of all cigarette waste properly. Do not lit-  
8           ter.’.

9           “(B) Not later than 180 days after the Ciga-  
10          rette Litter Prevention Act, the Secretary shall pro-  
11          mulgate regulations with respect to the placement,  
12          format, and type style of the label statement re-  
13          quired under subparagraph (A).”.

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
