A BILL

To authorize the Secretary of the Army to acquire land for the purpose of expanding Pinon Canyon Maneuver Site, and for other purposes.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. AUTHORITY TO ACQUIRE LAND FOR THE EX-
- 4 PANSION OF PINON CANYON MANEUVER
- 5 SITE.
- 6 (a) AUTHORITY.—The Secretary of the Army may,
- 7 subject to subsections (b) and (c), after consulting with
- 8 the congressional defense committees, and using funds
- 9 previously appropriated for such purpose, acquire for not
- 10 more than fair market value any and all right, title, and

- 1 interest in and to one or more parcels of real property
- 2 located near Pinon Canyon Maneuver Site (in this section
- 3 referred to as the "Site") for the purpose of expanding
- 4 the Site.
- 5 (b) LIMITATION ON EXPANSION.—The Secretary of
- 6 the Army may not acquire real property under subsection
- 7 (a) to expand the Site if such acquisition would require
- 8 the condemnation of such property, the seizure by a Fed-
- 9 eral entity of any private property, or the exercise by a
- 10 Federal or State governmental entity of eminent domain
- 11 authority.
- 12 (c) Study Required.—The Secretary of the Army
- 13 may not acquire real property under subsection (a) until
- 14 the Secretary has submitted to the congressional defense
- 15 committees a study on—
- 16 (1) the economic impact on local communities
- of such acquisition;
- 18 (2) the environmental impact of expanding the
- 19 Site pursuant to subsection (a); and
- 20 (3) the costs associated with potential environ-
- 21 mental restoration, waste management, and other
- 22 environmental activities in connection with such ac-
- 23 quisition and expansion.
- 24 (d) Definitions.—In this section:

(1) The term "congressional defense committees" means the Committee on Armed Services and the Committee on Appropriations of the Senate and the Committee on Armed Services and the Committee on Appropriations of the House of Representatives.

(2) The term "fair market value" means, with respect to a parcel of land, the value of such parcel as determined by an appraisal performed by an independent, certified appraiser in accordance with the Uniform Standards of Professional Appraisal Practice.
