To amend Public Law 108–67 to correct a provision relating to the conveyance of the Lake Tahoe Basin Management Unit.

- 3 SECTION 1. CORRECTION OF CONVEYANCE.
- 4 Section 2 of Public Law 108–67 (117 Stat. 880) is

- 6 (1) by striking "Subject to" and inserting the

- 8 "(a) IN GENERAL.—Subject to";

1 (2) in subsection (a) (as designated by para-2 graph (1)), by striking "the parcel" and all that fol-3 lows and inserting the following: "and to a portion 4 comprising approximately 23 acres of land of Lots 5 3 and 4, as depicted on the United States and En-6 cumbrance Map, revised January 10, 1991, for the 7 Toiyabe National Forest, Ranger District Carson-1, 8 and more particularly described as S½NW½SE½ 9 and N¹/₂SW¹/₄SE¹/₄ of sec. 27, T. 15 N., R. 18 E., 10 Mt. Diablo Base and Meridian."; and 11 (3) by adding at the end the following: "(b) Public Access and Use.—Nothing in this Act 12 prohibits any approved general public access (through existing easements or by boat) to or use of land remaining 14 15 within the Lake Tahoe Basin Management Unit after the conveyance to the Secretary of the Interior, in trust for 16 the Tribe, under subsection (a), including access to and 18 use of the beach and shoreline areas adjacent to the portion of land conveyed under that subsection.".
