A BILL

- To ensure efficiency and fairness in the awarding of Federal contracts in connection with Hurricane Katrina and Hurricane Rita reconstruction efforts.
 - 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
 - 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Local Disaster Con-
- 5 tracting Fairness Act of 2006".

6 SEC. 2. FEDERAL CONTRACTING REQUIREMENTS.

7 (a) IN GENERAL.—The head of an executive agency
8 may not enter into an agreement for debris removal or
9 demolition services in connection with Hurricane Katrina

or Hurricane Rita reconstruction efforts unless the agree ment specifies that—

3 (1) all of the work under the contract will be
4 performed by the prime contractor or one or more
5 subcontractors at one tier under the contract;

6 (2) any work performed under the contract by 7 subcontractors will be performed by local sub-8 contractors, except to the extent that local sub-9 contractors are not available to perform any such 10 work;

(3) the prime contractor will act as the project
manager or construction manager for the contract;
and

14 (4) the prime contractor—

15 (A) has primary responsibility for man-16 aging all work under the contract; and

17 (B) is to be paid a certain percentage of
18 the overall value of the contract as sole com19 pensation for assuming the risk associated with
20 such responsibility.

(b) PREFERENCE FOR SUBCONTRACTORS AFFECTED
BY HURRICANE KATRINA AND HURRICANE RITA.—In entering into an agreement for debris removal or demolition
services in connection with Hurricane Katrina or Hurricane Rita reconstruction efforts, the head of an executive

agency shall give a preference in the source selection proc-1 2 ess to each offeror who certifies that any work that is to 3 be performed under the contract by subcontractors will be 4 performed by local subcontractors. 5 (c) DEFINITIONS.—In this Act: (1) The term "executive agency" has the mean-6 7 ing given such term in section 4 of the Office of 8 Federal Procurement Policy Act (41 U.S.C. 403). 9 (2) The term "local subcontractor" means, with 10 respect to a contract, a subcontractor who— 11 (A) has a principal place of business or 12 regularly conducts operations in the area in 13 which work is to be performed under the con-14 tract by the subcontractor; and 15 (B)(i) was located, as of August 28, 2005, 16 in the area in which the President declared a 17 major disaster as a result of Hurricane 18 Katrina; or 19 (ii) was located as of September 23, 2005, 20 in the area in which the President declared a 21 major disaster as a result of Hurricane Rita.

1 SEC. 3. APPLICABILITY.

2 The requirements under section 2 shall apply to3 agreements entered into on or after the date of the enact-4 ment of this Act.

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
