## AN ACT

To provide access to newspapers for blind or other persons with disabilities.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Free Newspaper Ac-
- 5 cess for Blind and Other Persons with Disabilities Act".

## 1 SEC. 2. AUTHORIZATION OF PROGRAM.

- 2 (a) Program Authorized.—
- 3 (1) In General.—The Librarian of Congress 4 is authorized, subject to the availability of appro-5 priations, to pay telecommunications costs for blind 6 and other persons with disabilities to have interstate 7 free access to electronic editions of periodicals and 8 newspapers, disseminated in specialized audio and 9 electronic text formats and available contempora-10 neously with their print editions, from a multi-State 11 nonprofit source described in paragraph (2).
  - (2) Multi-State nonprofit source referred to in paragraph (1) shall be an entity that obtains content from publishers for free distribution of 1 or more periodicals or newspapers to blind and other persons with disabilities in each State in which eligible persons receive books and other publications supplied by the Librarian of Congress under the Act entitled "An Act to provide books for the adult blind", approved March 3, 1931 (2 U.S.C. 135a).
- (b) DEFINITION OF BLIND AND OTHER PERSONS
  WITH DISABILITIES.—In this section, the term "blind and
  other persons with disabilities" means individuals who are
  eligible or who may qualify, in accordance with the Act
  entitled "An Act to provide books for the adult blind",
