## A BILL

To extend temporarily the reduction of duty on Thiamethoxam technical.

1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the United States of America in Congress assembled, SECTION 1. THIAMETHOXAM TECHNICAL. 4 (a) IN GENERAL.— 5 (1) AMENDMENT.—Heading 9902.03.11 of the 6 Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the United States 7 (relating to Thiamethoxam Technical) is amended by 8 striking the article description and inserting the following: "3-[(2-Chloro-5-thiazolyl)methyl]tetrahydro-9 5-methyl-N-nitro-1,3,5-oxadiazin-4-imine) 10

2	for in subheading 2934.10.90)".
3	(2) Effective date.—The amendment made
4	by subsection (a) apply to goods entered, or with-
5	drawn from warehouse for consumption, on or after
