## A BILL

To extend temporarily the reduction of duty on  
Thiamethoxam technical.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3       **SECTION 1. THIAMETHOXAM TECHNICAL.**

4       (a) IN GENERAL.—

5               (1) AMENDMENT.—Heading 9902.03.11 of the  
6       Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the United States  
7       (relating to Thiamethoxam Technical) is amended by  
8       striking the article description and inserting the fol-  
9       lowing: “3-[(2-Chloro-5-thiazolyl)methyl]tetrahydro-  
10       5-methyl-N-nitro-1,3,5-oxadiazin-4-imine)

(Thiamethoxam) (CAS No. 153719–23–4) (provided for in subheading 2934.10.90)”.  
for in subheading 2934.10.90)”.  
(2) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by subsection (a) apply to goods entered, or withdrawn from warehouse for consumption, on or after the 15th day after the date of the enactment of this Act.

(b) CALENDAR YEARS 2006–2008.—

(1) IN GENERAL.—Heading 9902.03.11 of the Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the United States is amended—

(A) by striking “3.2%” and inserting “1.5%”; and

(B) by striking “12/31/2006” and inserting “12/31/2008”.

(2) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendments made by paragraph (1) shall take effect on January 1, 2006.

(c) CALENDAR YEAR 2009.—

(1) IN GENERAL.—Heading 9902.03.11, as amended by this section, is further amended—

(A) by striking “1.5%” and inserting “3.0%”; and

(B) by striking “12/31/2008” and inserting “12/31/2009”.

1           (2) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendments made  
2       by paragraph (1) shall take effect on January 1,  
3       2009.
