## A BILL

To extend temporarily the suspension of duty on  
Thiamethoxam technical.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3       **SECTION 1. THIAMETHOXAM TECHNICAL.**

4       (a) IN GENERAL.—Heading 9902.03.11 of the Har-  
5       monized Tariff Schedule of the United States (relating to  
6       Thiamethoxam Technical) is amended—

7               (1) by striking the article description and in-  
8       serting the following:

9       “3-[(2-Chloro-5-thiazolyl)methyl]tetrahydro-5-meth-  
10       yl-N-nitro-1,3,5-oxadiazin-4-imine) (Thiamethoxam) (CAS

1 No. 153719–23–4) (provided for in subheading  
2 2934.10.90)”).

3 (2) by striking “2.54%” and inserting “Free”;  
4 and

5 (3) by striking “12/31/2005” and inserting  
6 “12/31/2009”.

7 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendments made by  
8 subsection (a) apply to goods entered, or withdrawn from  
9 warehouse for consumption, on or after the 15th day after  
10 the date of the enactment of this Act.
