- 6 monized Tariff Schedule of the United States (relating to
- 7 Methyl-4-trifluor omethoxyphenyl-N-(chlorocarbonyl) car-
- 8 bamate) is amended by striking "12/31/2006" and insert-
- 9 ing "12/31/2009".

- 1 (b) Effective Date.—The amendment made by
- 2 subsection (a) applies to goods entered, or withdrawn from
- 3 warehouse for consumption, on or after the 15th day after

4 the date of enactment of this Act.
