## A BILL

To suspend temporarily the duty on AC electric motors of  
an output exceeding 74.6 W but not exceeding 95 W.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. AC ELECTRIC MOTORS OF AN OUTPUT EXCEED-**  
4 **ING 74.6 W BUT NOT EXCEEDING 95 W.**

5 (a) IN GENERAL.—Subchapter II of chapter 99 of  
6 the Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the United States is  
7 amended by inserting in numerical sequence the following  
8 new heading:

“	9902.85.08	AC electric motors of an output exceeding 74.6 W but not exceeding 95 W, single phase, each equipped with a capacitor and a speed control mechanism (provided for in subheading 8501.40.40) .....	Free	No change	No change	On or before 12/31/2009	”.

1       (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by  
2 subsection (a) applies to goods entered, or withdrawn from  
3 warehouse for consumption, on or after the 15th day after  
4 the date of the enactment of this Act.
