1	Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-

3	SECTION 1. CERTAIN LAMINATE WOOD MOLDING MEAS-
4	URING LESS THAN 4-FEET IN LENGTH.
5	(a) In General.—Subchapter II of chapter 99 of
6	the Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the United States is
7	amended by inserting in numerical sequence the following
8	new heading:

" 9902.44.11 Certain laminate wood molding measuring less than 4-feet in length (provided for in subheading 4411.29.90) Free No change No change On or before

- 1 (b) Effective Date.—The amendment made by
- 2 subsection (a) applies to goods entered, or withdrawn from
- 3 warehouse for consumption, on or after the 15th day after

4 the date of the enactment of this Act.
