## A BILL

To extend the temporary suspension of duty on railway car body shells of stainless steel designed for use in gallery type cab control railway cars.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3       **SECTION 1. RAILWAY CAR BODY SHELLS OF STAINLESS**  
4                       **STEEL DESIGNED FOR USE IN GALLERY TYPE**  
5                       **CAB CONTROL RAILWAY CARS.**

6       (a) IN GENERAL.—Heading 9902.86.08 of the Har-  
7       monized Tariff Schedule of the United States (relating to  
8       railway car body shells of stainless steel designed for use  
9       in gallery type cab control railway cars) is amended by  
10       striking “12/31/2006” and inserting “12/31/2009”.

1       (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by  
2 subsection (a) applies to goods entered, or withdrawn from  
3 warehouse for consumption, on or after the 15th day after  
4 the date of the enactment of this Act.
