To provide for the mandatory revocation, in addition to the mandatory denial, of passports of individuals who have a certain level of child support arrearages.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. MANDATORY REVOCATION, IN ADDITION TO**
4 **THE MANDATORY DENIAL, OF PASSPORTS OF**
5 **INDIVIDUALS WHO ARE HAVE A CERTAIN**
6 **LEVEL OF CHILD SUPPORT ARREARAGES.**

7 Section 452(k) of the Social Security Act (42 U.S.C.
8 652(k)) is amended—

- 1 (1) in paragraph (1), by striking “, revocation,
2 or limitation” and inserting “or revocation”; and
3 (2) in paragraph (2), by striking “may revoke,
4 restrict, or limit” and inserting “shall revoke”.
