To amend title 38, United States Code, to make a stillborn child an insurable dependent for purposes of the Servicemembers' Group Life Insurance program.

- 3 SECTION 1. TREATMENT OF STILLBORN CHILDREN AS IN-
- 4 SURABLE DEPENDENTS UNDER
- 5 SERVICEMEMBERS' GROUP LIFE INSURANCE
- 6 PROGRAM.
- 7 (a) Treatment.—Section 1965 of title 38, United
- 8 States Code, is amended—

1	(1) in paragraph (10), by adding at the end the
2	following new subparagraph:
3	"(C) The member's stillborn natural
4	child."; and
5	(2) by adding at the end the following new
6	paragraph:
7	"(11)(A) Except as provided in subparagraph
8	(B), the term 'stillborn natural child' means a nat-
9	ural child—
10	"(i) whose death occurs before expulsion,
11	extraction, or delivery; and
12	"(ii) whose—
13	"(I) fetal weight is greater than 500
14	grams;
15	"(II) in the event fetal weight is un-
16	known, duration in utero exceeds 22 com-
17	pleted weeks of gestation; or
18	"(III) in the event neither fetal weight
19	nor duration in utero is known, body
20	length (crown-to-heel) is 25 centimeters or
21	more.
22	"(B) The term does not include any fetus or
23	child extracted for purposes of an abortion.".
24	(b) Conforming Amendment.—Section 101(4)(A)
25	of such title is amended by striking "section 1965(10)(B)"

- 2 graph (B) or (C) of section 1965(10)".
