1 vada, shall be known and designated as the “Mayor Tony
2 Armstrong Memorial Post Office”.

3 (b) REFERENCES.—Any reference in a law, map, reg-
4 ulation, document, paper, or other record of the United
5 States to the facility referred to in subsection (a) shall
6 be deemed to be a reference to the “Mayor Tony Arm-
7 strong Memorial Post Office”.
