- 4 BOR AND RIVER, MICHIGAN AND WISCONSIN.
- 5 (a) IN GENERAL.—The project for navigation, Me-
- 6 nominee Harbor and River, Michigan and Wisconsin, de-
- 7 authorized on April 15, 2002, in accordance with section
- 8 1001(b)(2) of the Water Resources Development Act of
- 9 1986 (33 U.S.C. 579a(b)(2)), shall be carried out by the

- 1 Secretary of the Army in accordance with section 101 of
- 2 the River and Harbor Act of 1960 (74 Stat. 482) at full
- 3 Federal expense.
- 4 (b) Costs and Benefits.—The Secretary of the
- 5 Army shall carry out the project described in subsection
- 6 (a) regardless of whether the benefits of the project exceed
- 7 the estimated costs of the project.
