## A BILL

To amend the Safe Drinking Water Act to clarify the definition of the term “underground injection”.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3       **SECTION 1. HYDRAULIC FRACTURING.**

4       Section 1421(d) of the Safe Drinking Water Act (42  
5       U.S.C. 300h(d)) is amended by striking paragraph (1) and  
6       inserting the following:

7               “(1) DEFINITION OF UNDERGROUND INJEC-  
8       TION.—

1           “(A) IN GENERAL.—The term ‘under-  
2           ground injection’ means the subsurface em-  
3           placement of fluids by well injection.

4           “(B) EXCLUSION.—The term ‘under-  
5           ground injection’ does not include—

6                   “(i) the underground injection of nat-  
7                   ural gas for purposes of storage; or

8                   “(ii) the underground injection of  
9                   fluids or propping agents pursuant to hy-  
10                  draulic fracturing operations relating to oil  
11                  or gas production activities.”.
