## A BILL

To authorize funding for the American Prosecutors Research Institute's National Center for Prosecution of Child Abuse and the American Prosecutors Research Institute's National Child Protection Training Center at Winona State University.

1        *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2        *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3        **SECTION 1. AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.**

4        There are authorized to be appropriated for grants  
5        pursuant to section 214A of the Victims of Child Abuse  
6        Act of 1990 (42 U.S.C. 13003) for technical assistance

1 and training programs (in addition to amounts previously  
2 authorized)—

3           (1) \$4,500,000 for each of the fiscal years 2006  
4 through 2010 to the American Prosecutors Research  
5 Institute's National Center for Prosecution of Child  
6 Abuse; and

7           (2) \$3,000,000 for each of the fiscal years 2006  
8 through 2010 to the American Prosecutors Research  
9 Institute's National Child Protection Training Cen-  
10 ter at Winona State University.
