- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Strengthen Social

SOCIAL WORK TRAINING PROGRAM. 2 Subpart 2 of part E of title VII of the Public Health 3 Service Act (42 U.S.C. 295 et seq.) is amended— 4 (1) by redesignating section 770 as section 5 770A; 6 (2) by inserting after section 769, the following: 7 "SEC. 770. SOCIAL WORK TRAINING PROGRAM. 8 "(a) Training Generally.—The Secretary may make grants to, or enter into contracts with, any public or nonprofit private hospital, any school offering programs 10 11 in social work, or to or with a public or private nonprofit entity that the Secretary has determined is capable of car-12 13 rying out such grant or contract— "(1) to plan, develop, and operate, or partici-14 15 pate in, an approved social work training program 16 (including an approved residency or internship pro-17 gram) for students, interns, residents, or practicing 18 physicians; 19 "(2) to provide financial assistance (in the form 20 of traineeships and fellowships) to students, interns, 21 residents, practicing physicians, or other individuals, 22 who-"(A) are in need of such assistance; 23

4	which payments are made to an entity from an award of

11	"(1) Authorization of appropriations.—

3	place the term appears;
4	(2) in paragraph (4)(A), by striking "and psy-
5	chologists" and inserting "psychologists, and clinical

7	(3) in paragraph (5), by inserting "clinical so-
8	cial work," after "psychology,".
