

S. CON. RES. 103

CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

1 *Resolved by the Senate (the House of Representatives*
2 *concurring)*, That in the enrollment of the bill H.R. 889,
3 the Clerk of the House of Representatives shall make the
4 following corrections:

5 (1) In the table of contents in section 2, strike
6 the item relating to section 414 and insert the fol-
7 lowing:

“Sec. 414. Navigational safety of certain facilities.”.

8 (2) Strike section 414 and insert the following:

9 **“SEC. 414. NAVIGATIONAL SAFETY OF CERTAIN FACILITIES.**

10 “(a) CONSIDERATION OF ALTERNATIVES.—In re-
11 viewing a lease, easement, or right-of-way for an offshore
12 wind energy facility in Nantucket Sound under section
13 8(p) of the Outer Continental Shelf Lands Act (43 U.S.C.
14 1337(p)), not later than 60 days before the date estab-
15 lished by the Secretary of the Interior for publication of
16 a draft environmental impact statement, the Commandant
17 of the Coast Guard shall specify the reasonable terms and
18 conditions the Commandant determines to be necessary to

1 provide for navigational safety with respect to the pro-
2 posed lease, easement, or right-of-way and each alternative
3 to the proposed lease, easement, or right-of-way consid-
4 ered by the Secretary.

5 “(b) INCLUSION OF NECESSARY TERMS AND CONDI-
6 TIONS.—In granting a lease, easement, or right-of-way for
7 an offshore wind energy facility in Nantucket Sound under
8 section 8(p) of the Outer Continental Shelf Lands Act (43
9 U.S.C. 1337(p)), the Secretary shall incorporate in the
10 lease, easement, or right-of-way reasonable terms and con-
11 ditions the Commandant determines to be necessary to
12 provide for navigational safety.”.
