## CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

Permitting the use of the rotunda of the Capitol for a ceremony to honor Constantino Brumidi on the 200th anniversary of his birth.

1       *Resolved by the Senate (the House of Representatives*  
2 *concurring)*, That the rotunda of the Capitol is authorized  
3 to be used on July 26, 2005, for a ceremony to honor  
4 Constantino Brumidi on the 200th anniversary of his  
5 birth. Physical preparations for the ceremony shall be car-  
6 ried out in accordance with such conditions as the Archi-  
7 tect of the Capitol may prescribe.
