# CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

Authorizing the remains of Rosa Parks to lie in honor in the rotunda of the Capitol.

1        *Resolved by the Senate (the House of Representatives*  
2 *concurring), That, in recognition of the historic contribu-*  
3 *tions of Rosa Parks, her remains be permitted to lie in*  
4 *honor in the rotunda of the Capitol from October 30 to*  
5 *October 31, 2005, so that the citizens of the United States*  
6 *may pay their last respects to this great American. The*  
7 *Architect of the Capitol, under the direction and super-*  
8 *vision of the President pro tempore of the Senate and the*  
9 *Speaker of the House of Representatives, shall take all*  
10 *necessary steps for the accomplishment of that purpose.*
