## JOINT RESOLUTION

Providing for the appointment of Shirley Ann Jackson as  
a citizen regent of the Board of Regents of the Smithso-  
nian Institution.

1       *Resolved by the Senate and House of Representatives*  
2 *of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*  
3 That, in accordance with section 5581 of the Revised Stat-  
4 utes (20 U.S.C. 43), the vacancy on the Board of Regents  
5 of the Smithsonian Institution (in the class other than  
6 Members of Congress) occurring because of the expiration  
7 of the term of Hanna H. Gray of Illinois on April 13,  
8 2005, is filled by the appointment of Shirley Ann Jackson  
9 of New York, for a term of 6 years, beginning on the later

1 of April 13, 2005, or the date on which this resolution  
2 becomes law.
