Mr. LOTT (for himself and Mr. DODD) submitted the following resolution;
which was considered and agreed to

RESOLUTION

To authorize the display of the Senate Leadership Portrait
Collection in the Senate Lobby.

Whereas the objective of the Senate Leadership Portrait Col-
lection is to commemorate the distinguished service to the
Senate and the Nation of those Senators who have served
as Majority Leader, Minority Leader, or President pro
tempore: Now, therefore, be it

1 *Resolved*, That (a) portraits in the Senate Leadership
2 Portrait Collection may be displayed in the Senate Lobby
3 at the direction of the Senate Commission on Art in ac-
4 cordance with guidelines prescribed pursuant to subsection
5 (d).

1 (b) The Senate Leadership Portrait Collection shall
2 consist of portraits selected by the Senate Commission on
3 Art of Majority or Minority Leaders and Presidents pro
4 tempore of the Senate.

5 (c) Any portrait for the Senate Leadership Portrait
6 Collection that is acquired on or after the date of adoption
7 of this resolution shall be of an appropriate size for display
8 in the Senate Lobby, as determined by the Senate Com-
9 mission on Art.

10 (d) The Senate Commission on Art shall prescribe
11 such guidelines as it deems necessary, subject to the ap-
12 proval of the Committee on Rules and Administration, to
13 carry out this resolution.
