## RESOLUTION

Authorizing the taking of video images in the Chamber of  
the United States Senate.

1       *Resolved,*

2       **SECTION 1. AUTHORIZATION OF TAKING OF VIDEO IMAGES**

3                       **IN SENATE CHAMBER.**

4       (a) **AUTHORIZATION.**—Subject to subsection (b),  
5 paragraph 1 of rule IV of the Rules for the Regulation  
6 of the Senate Wing of the United States Capitol and Sen-  
7 ate Office Buildings (prohibiting the taking of pictures in  
8 the Senate Chamber) is temporarily suspended for the  
9 purpose of permitting the C-SPAN television network to

1 take, during a period the Senate is in recess, video images  
2 of the Senate Chamber.

3 (b) LIMITATION ON USE OF IMAGES.—The C-SPAN  
4 television network may use video images taken under sub-  
5 section (a) solely for inclusion in a documentary on the  
6 history of the United States Capitol which the network  
7 is preparing.

8 (c) ARRANGEMENTS.—The Sergeant at Arms and  
9 Doorkeeper of the Senate shall make the necessary ar-  
10 rangements to carry out this resolution, including such ar-  
11 rangements as are necessary to ensure that the taking of  
12 video images under this resolution does not disrupt any  
13 proceeding of the Senate.
