5 (a) AUTHORIZATION.—Subject to subsection (b),
6 paragraph 1 of rule IV of the Rules for the Regulation
7 of the Senate Wing of the United States Capitol and Senate Office Buildings (prohibiting the taking of pictures in
9 the Senate Chamber) is temporarily suspended for the

10 purpose of permitting the taking of pictures while the Sen-

- 1 ate is in session or in recess for the period beginning on
- 2 the date of adoption of this resolution and ending October
- 3 31, 2005, at locations and times to be determined by the
- 4 Committee on Rules and Administration.
- 5 (b) Limitation on Use of Images.—The pictures
- 6 taken under subsection (a) may only be used by the Cap-
- 7 itol Visitor Center for a video presentation in the Capitol
- 8 Visitor Center after the video presentation has been ap-
- 9 proved by the Committee on Rules and Administration.
- 10 (c) Arrangements.—The Sergeant at Arms and
- 11 Doorkeeper of the Senate shall make the necessary ar-
- 12 rangements to carry out this resolution, including such ar-
- 13 rangements as are necessary to ensure that the taking of
- 14 pictures under this resolution does not disrupt any pro-
- 15 ceeding of the Senate.
