RESOLUTION

Expressing the sense of the Senate on the discussion by the North Atlantic Council of secure, sustainable, and reliable sources of energy.

Resolved, That it is the sense of the Senate that—
(1) the President should place on the agenda
for discussion at the North Atlantic Council, as soon
as practicable, the merits of establishing a policy
and strategy for the North Atlantic Treaty Organi zation to promote the security of members of the Or-

1	ganization through the development of secure, sus-
2	tainable, and reliable sources of energy; and
3	(2) the President should submit to Congress a
4	report that sets forth—
5	(A) the actions the United States has
6	taken to place the matter referred to in para-
7	graph (1) on the agenda for discussion at the
8	North Atlantic Council;
9	(B) the position of the United States on
10	the matter, as communicated to the North At-
11	lantic Council by the representatives of the
12	United States to the Council;
13	(C) a summary of the debate on the mat-
14	ter at the North Atlantic Council, including any
15	decision that has been reached with respect to
16	the matter by the Council; and
17	(D) a strategy for the North Atlantic
18	Treaty Organization to develop secure, sustain-
19	able, and reliable sources of energy, including
20	contingency plans if current energy resources
21	are put at risk.
