RESOLUTION

Proclaiming the week of May 21 through May 27, 2006, as "National Public Works Week".

- Whereas public works infrastructure, facilities, and services are of vital importance to the health, safety, and wellbeing of the people of the United States;
- Whereas those facilities and services could not be provided without the dedicated efforts of public works professionals, engineers, and administrators who represent State and local governments throughout the United States;
- Whereas those individuals design, build, operate, and maintain the transportation systems, water supply infrastructure, sewage and refuse disposal systems, public buildings, and other structures and facilities that are vital to the citizens and communities of the United States; and

Whereas it is in the interest of the public for citizens and
civic leaders to understand the role that public infrastruc
ture plays in—
(1) protecting the environment;
(2) improving public health and safety;
(3) contributing to economic vitality; and
(4) enhancing the quality of life of every community
of the United States: Now, therefore, be it
